

Odds and Ends

If your book is extra long you might consider recording it in several volumes. That spreads out the production costs and increases revenue.

Most audio books in MP3 format will fit on one CD. MP3s can be played on computers, MP3 players or Ipods. If you want your audio book to be played on regular CD players or in car CD players it will require many CDs. For example, one six-hour audio book for sale on the internet requires eleven CDs. There is an extra charge to produce CDS for CD players.

We can produce MP3 CDs of your audio book for you to sell or give away. If you create a four color front for the CD the price is \$2.40 each plus shipping. If you have just a black ink front the price is \$2.00 each plus shipping. You will probably want MP3 CDs to provide to the media for publicity.

If you have other books you write a special segment for the end of your audio book and if you have a website you should mention that. You probably want to mention acknowledgements here also. If your book is already in print you can promote the sale of copies in addition to bringing it alive with your audio book.

We are an audio book producing company and a web hosting company but not a marketing company. You will drive potential buyers to your or our website to create sales. We are developing ideas to make people aware of our audio book web hosting site but that is not our primary purpose. As we add more audio books more people will find your book which they can purchase. If you decide to post your book on our website you can also post it elsewhere. We do not require exclusivity.

No matter what website you are on we feel you should offer the first chapter or some section of the book free to entice potential buyers to become buyers. If you use our webhosting service we can help you with that as part of the setup.

VERY IMPORTANT. If you have ever entered into an agreement of any kind for your book you must be certain you still own the rights to it. You could go to the time, effort and expense to record your book only to find out you don't own the rights. Please think about this carefully.

If after starting to record your book you decide not to continue we will refund \$100 of the \$299 down payment upon return of our equipment and the project will stop there.

We have male and female talent who can record your book for you. The rate is \$350 per hour or fraction of an hour times the length of the final version. After you provide us with a word count we estimate the total cost. You pay \$500 upon agreement. We will record one page and email the MP3 to you. When you email us that you accept our talent the \$500 partial payment becomes non-refundable and we record the book. You make another \$500 payment that is non-refundable. We edit the book and you pay balance based on \$350 per hour times the actual length of the book. At that point you will get the MP3 CD of your book.

If you give us information about writer's groups you belong to we'll post the name of the group, when and where it meets and the main contact information on our website.

Good Impressions is continuing to contact authors, writers groups, publishers, literary agents and intellectual property attorneys to add more audio books to our library. There is always the possibility a literary agent or a publishers will discover your audio book on our web site and contact you.
