

How do we calculate the costs?

You provide us with a word count of your manuscript. We calculate an estimate of the time it will take you to record it based on a time-tested formula. **There is a minimum fee of \$499.** You pay \$299 as a partial payment of the estimated total. We ship our recording equipment to you and tell you how to access the video we created on our website about making the best recording possible.

When you finish recording your manuscript you send our recording equipment back to us. We calculate the total cost based on the time registered on the equipment. That tells us what the actual total dollar amount is. We subtract the \$299 you already paid and you send us the balance. Sometimes the total is slightly more than the estimate and sometimes it is slightly less depending on the actual time it took you to record your audio book. Our formula is pretty accurate.

At that point our professional editors go to work. We create an audio copyright notice for the beginning of your audio book. Our pros edit out all the mistakes you noted on the “mistake sheet” we provide. If you opted for music at the start and end of each chapter our editors add those. Then we use our special customized editing tools and our years of knowledge to improve and enhance the sound of your audio book.

We then send you a master CD with your completed audio book in MP3 format. If you find other errors as you listen to it we will edit those out at no additional charge. If you want to re-record portions there are additional fees for that.
